Jacob Hallman's Will

In the name of God Amen I
Jacob Hallman of the County of Lincoln
and State of North Carolina Being of
Sound mind and perfect memory bless'd
be God do on this 24th day of December in
the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred
and fifty make & publish this to be my
last Will and Testament in manner and form
as follows that is to say 1st I will & bequeath unto
my beloved wife Elizabeth during her lifetime
my home plantation also all my house and
kitchen furniture. Excepting such things as she
may not wish to keep if any such they may
be sold with other property also the old cow my
Waggon and pump horse two head of sheep
one sow and six Shoats also choice of two young
hogs, and at the death of my wife Elizabeth
my will is that all her property be Equally divi-
-dided between my three daughters Mary
Susannah & Rody by Consent or else put to
sale and the money arising from the sale
Equally divided between the three above named
Daughters 2nd I will and bequeath unto my
daughter Fanny Ten acres of Land Including

by God do on this 24th day of December in
the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred
and fifty make & publish this to be my
last Will and Testament in manner and form
as follows that is to say 1st I will & bequeath unto
my beloved wife Elizabeth during her lifetime
my home plantation also all my house and
kitchen furniture. Excepting such things as she
may not wish to keep if any such they may
be sold with other property also the old cow my
Bay mare and pump horse two head of sheep
one sow and six shoats also choice of two young
hogs, and at the death of my wife Elizabeth
my will is that all her property be equally divi-
ded between my three daughters Fanny
Susannah & Hedy by consent or else put to
sale and the money arising from the sale
equally divided between the three above named
Daughters 2nd I will and bequeath unto my
daughter Fanny Ten acres of Land including
the meadow that is now called hers binding on
running with Blacks Creek and Lockarts bank
so as to make the number of acres 3rd I also
give and bequeath unto my Son Anthony
fifteen acres of Land joining his own

Tract of Land commencing at his line
 and running down to a dead Apple Tree
 in the flat near to a Cherry Trees and from
 that across to Wiley Hallmans Line so as
 to make the fifteen acres also my half of
 the Waggow after my wifes death 1th I also
 give and bequeath to my son George Twelve
 Acres of Land of the home tract on these
 Conditions that he George Hallman first give
 up our note which he holds against me for
 Twenty five dollars 5th I also give and bequeath
 unto my son Benjamin Fifteen Acres of Land
 of the home tract on these conditions that he Ben-
 jamin Hallman pay to his brother Anthony Hallman
 a sum of money amounting to one hundred and
 fifteen dollars which Anthony Hallman paid
 to John Boyd for Benjamin Hallman as security
 money, the two last lots mentioned is to be laid
 off during Harveys lot, 6th I give and bequeath
 unto my grand Daughter M. C. Bridges seven
 Acres of my home tract of Land. During
 the above mentioned lots if she should not live
 to be of age the Land is to fall back to my Children
 7th My further will is that all the balance of
 home tract of Land shall be equally divided
 between my son Israel and Daughters Elizabeth
 Susan and Rose 8th I also give and bequeath

to make the fifteen acres also my half of
the Waggow after my wife's death 1st I also
give and bequeath to my son George Twelve
Acres of Land of the home tract on these
Conditions that he George Hallman first give
up our note which he holds against me for
Twenty five dollars \$5⁰⁰ I also give and bequeath
unto my son Benjamin Fifteen Acres of Land
of the home tract on these conditions that he Ben-
jamin Hallman pay to his brother Anthony Hallman
a sum of money amounting to one hundred and
fifteen dollars which Anthony Hallman paid
to John Boyd for Benjamin Hallman as security
money, the two last lots mentioned is to be made
off coming Harrys lot, 6th I give and bequeath
unto my grand daughter A. M. C. Bridges Seven
Acres of my home tract of Land. Giving
the above mentioned lots if she should not live
to be of age the Land is to fall back to my children
7th My further will is that all the balance of
home tract of Land shall be equally divided
between my son Israel and Daughters Elizabeth
Susannah & Rody, 8th I also give and bequeath
unto my daughter Rody my Ball mare and
my young cow also three bedsteads and
clothing for the same such as her sisters
Rebecca also the saddle and bridle she now

Claims and one Chest worth five Dollars
 to be bought out of the Estate for her. also
 two sets of Plates Coffee pot. Sugar dish one Set
 of Knives and forks two sets of Spoons Wash pot
 two little pots one oven and a frying pan one
 little Spinning Wheel cards two Churn six
 chairs Smoothing Iron, I do hereby appoint
 my son Anthony Hallman Executor of this my
 last will and Testament In Witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal the
 day and year above written
