In the Name of God Amen & I Jacob  
Hoffman of the County of Franklin State of or with hands  
being far advanced in Years & infirm in body  
but of sound mind & memory & calling to mind that  
it is appointed for all men once to die do the 17<sup>th</sup>  
day of August 1830 make & ordain this my last will  
& Testament. In the first place I commend my soul  
to the hand of Almighty god who gave it & my body  
to the earth to be buried in decent Christian like  
manner at the discretion of my executors - also  
as to the worldly estate wherewithal it hath pleased  
god to bless me in this life, I give advise &  
bequeath in the following manner. To my wife, I give  
& bequeath to my wife Barbara one bed of furniture  
also all the kitchen utensils such as pots, pans,  
claypots, Knives forks &c. Also my bedding, chair & pump  
& her living in the house where I now dwelle & a decent  
& reasonable maintenance during her natural life to be  
furnished to her by my son Jacob in consideration of  
the property which I have hereinafter mentioned  
to him. I will & bequeath to my daughter Barbara  
Reinhardt twelve & a half Cents to my daughter Elizabeth  
Barbara twelve Shillings & 6 Cents to my daughter Anna Sally  
Twelve & half Cents to my daughter Polly Harris Thirteen & a  
half Cents to my son John Hoffman twelve & a half cents  
& to my son Jacob Hoffman all the remainder of my  
estate both real & personal & wheresoever it may be  
which I may own at the time of my decease to him  
his heirs & assigns forever & that they said son Jacob  
shall pay all my just debts, lastly I do hereby nominate  
& appoint my said son Jacob Hoffman the sole Executor  
of this my last will & Testament & I do hereby revoke  
as much & disallow all former wills by me made  
& declare this document to be my last will & Testament  
for witness whereof I have hereunto set my  
hand & seal the day & year first above written  
Signed sealed published & declared by Jacob Hoffmann  
to be his last will & Testament in the presence of us
