In the Name of God Amen & I make & signe this
of the County of Lancaster & State of North Carolina being
of sound perfect mind & memory before me god
for his mercies to me do this 23rd day of May in the
Year of our Lord 1829. I make & publish this as my
last Will & Testament in the manner following viz

I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Catharine
during her living off the plantation where I now live
during her lifetime or widowhood my negro girl
named Maria & my yellow boy Isaac & my bay
Mare named Bill, saddle & bridle two cows &
Calves her choice of my stock. One Beef for her
of hogs six heads of sheep two head horses & furniture
of different furniture all the household & kitchen fur
niture, her choice of the stock in case there is
the quantity of stock in my possession at my decease
to remain in her possession during her natural lifetime
of two hundred and at either of the above named
periods & without all that remains of the above named
property or their increase (except my yellow boy
Isaac as hereinafter mentioned) and my negro girl
Maria as hereinafter mentioned, to be equally
divided between my children; that is to say
the negro girl above named to my son James
because if in case he has any of his own body of
at least twenty all the above named property
except my yellow boy Isaac to be divided between
my sons Peter Fair, Jacob Fair, John Fair, George
Fair, Sarah Fair, Joseph Fair & Anna Fair

Also I give & bequeath unto my son Daniel Fair
two hundred acres of land including his improved
plantation where he now lives off the north end of the
different tract to be laid off as follows to him
to be used his alterations

3rd I give and bequeath unto my son Samuel
said the tract of land where I now live containing
an acre & surveys supposed to be 300 acres
more or less at my wifes decease or marriage and
in case that the aforesaid Samuel shall have no
heirs of his own body. I about the land above men-
tioned to fall into the hands of my sons that is Peter
Sain, Jacob Sain, Joseph Sain, John Sain George
Sain, & Daniel Sain, each an equal part. Also
with the lands of the widow of said Samue shall
that proper to live on said land. She shall
have full possession of the same during her
natural life time or widowhood. after my
wifes decease & in case she marries or removes
off said land it is to fall on the possession of
my sons above named. And also all my
son Samuel my waggon & mds. gears and
the balance of all my farming tools unto my
wife Catharine until her decease or marriage
at either of said periods to fall into the hands
of my sons before mentioned.

4th I give & bequeath unto my son that is Peter
Sain. Jacob Sain, & Daniel Sain, my negro
woman named Ruth. My negro girl named Kip
my negro girl named Hare & their increase to be
equally divided between my three sons above named.

5th I give & bequeath unto my son John Sain
one hundred dollars out of my estate of personal
property if there is enough left over off
mentioned.

6th I give & bequeath unto my yellow boy
Kip his freedom as a person of color when
he arrives to the age of twenty one years.

I had a talk with the people here of my wife Catharine
I have been trying to get a man of land as I have
brought my son Daniel along with me and master, Lucia &
now, should be to build about on the South side, one
Mattock one bar & bear plough one cart & cart or
ten dollars in money one bed & bedding & furnaces &c
to send my wife to give my children by their father
made & I allow my wife Catharine the sum of Sixty
dollars to be paid out of my estate to her for
education & clothing

To the balance of my effects to not herofore given
my children that is Peter Law, Jacob Law, David Law
John Law, Samuel Law, George Law, Catharine Law
each an equal share and so do hereby direct
and my wife Catharine Law & my son Daniel
Execution of this my last will & testament & my
will & testament whereof the said Jacob Law has a copy of
my last will & testament set my hand and seal
the 27th of July 1806 above written
Signed, sealed, published
of & a copy of it delivered
to James Wilson attorney
