## James Hansell's Will

In the name of God Amen, I James  
Hansell of the County of Lincoln and State  
of North Carolina, considering the uncertainty  
of this life and being in perfect mind  
and memory Blessed be God, do this 12<sup>th</sup>  
day of December in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and  
forty seven, Make and publish this my  
last will and Testament in the following  
manner First I will my body to be buried  
in a Christian like manner at the expense  
of my personal estate, 2<sup>d</sup> I will to my  
beloved Wife Susan Hansell my

Tract of land wherein I now live, one cow  
 & calf, one bay horse, and ~~at~~ my house hold  
 & kitchen furniture also my stock of hogs during  
 his natural life; and after his death to be  
 divided in the following manner to wit

3<sup>rd</sup> I will and bequeath unto Peter Wingate  
 & his wife Elizabeth seventy two acres of land  
 to be laid off of the upper end of my land  
 so as to include both sides of the creek where  
 the said Wingate now lives — 4<sup>th</sup> I will and  
 bequeath unto David Hingcade & his wife Dor-  
 shala seventy two acres of land to commence  
 on the line of Peter Wingate and run off in like  
 manner so as to include both sides of the creek

5<sup>th</sup> I will unto George Mauny and his  
 wife Savina seventy two acres of land to  
 commence on the line of said Hingcade  
 and run off so as to include both sides of  
 the creek, 6<sup>th</sup> I will and bequeath unto my  
 daughter Polly Harsill seventy two acres  
 of land to commence on the line of George  
 Mauny and run off so as to include  
 both sides of the creek — 7<sup>th</sup> I will and

bequeath unto my son Hubbard Harsill  
 the balance of my Tract of land lying on  
 both sides the creek, and in case it —

deceased in the following manner to wit

- 3<sup>rd</sup> I will and bequeath unto Peter Wingate & his wife Elizabeth seventy two acres of land to be laid off of the upper end of my land so as to include both sides of the creek where the said Wingate now lives —
- 4<sup>th</sup> I will and bequeath unto David Kinglee & his wife Bonshalia seventy two acres of land to commence on the line of Peter Wingate and run off in like manner so as to include both sides of the creek
- 5<sup>th</sup> I will unto George Mauny and his wife Larina seventy two acres of land to commence on the line of said Kinglee and run off so as to include both sides of the creek,
- 6<sup>th</sup> I will and bequeath unto my daughter Polly Hansell seventy two acres of land to commence on the line of George Mauny and run off so as to include both sides of the creek —
- 7<sup>th</sup> I will and bequeath unto my son Hubert Hansell the balance of my Tract of land lying on both sides of the creek, and in case it should not hold out, the seventy two acres all my other children pay him in proportion to make up equal to the seventy two acres to them and their heirs or assigns forever
- 8<sup>th</sup> It is my will and desire that in

ease my daughter Polly should not marry  
 and die without any children that he be  
 be sold by executor to the highest bidder  
 and the proceeds to be equally divided  
 between Lurina Mauney, Elizabeth Wingate  
 Baishote Wingate and Hubbard Hans-  
 -ill or their Representatives - 9<sup>th</sup> I will  
 and desire that George Mauney or his  
 Representatives pay over to Henry Han-  
 -sill my son the sum of Twelve dollars  
 in cash, also that Peter Wingate pay over to my  
 son Henry the sum of twelve dollars in cash  
 also that Polly Hansill my daughter pay over  
 to Henry Hansill my son Twelve dollars in cash  
 also that David Wingate pay over to my  
 son Henry Hansill the sum of Twelve  
 dollars and also that my son Hubbard Hans-  
 -ill pay over to Henry Hansill the sum of  
 Twelve dollars - I further will and desire  
 that my waggon shall be a Joint Stock  
 between my son Hubbard, Harriet, Peter  
 Wingate and David Wingate to be used  
 by each of them as they may need or wish
