

The following of Wills was proved in open Court & admitted to record by

Mr James Hollard of the County of Surry in
the State of North Carolina in a Weak State of
Body but in common exercise of mind do on the 28th
day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and thirty six make and give in
disposition of all my Estate both real and personal
in the Manner and form following.

To my beloved wife Elizabeth Hollard I give
a bed and furniture and to my son Andrew
Hollard one Bed and furniture to my Daughter
Catharine Hollard one bed and furniture
And to the child of which my wife is now pregnant
one bed and furniture said Beds and furniture to be ad-
judged by my executors of equal value. To my Daughter Rebekah
Adaline daughter of Anne Moore I will and direct that my
executors purchase a negro Girl worth about three hundred
Dollars and a Horse Saddle and Bridle worth about Twenty
Eighty Dollars which negro and horse &c I allow my execu-
tors to give to her for her use at three years from this Date
which said property shall only be considered as loaned to her
the said Rebekah until she arrives at the age of 21 years and
should she live to be 21 years of age or leave this world
I then allow said property to go absolutely to her and her heirs
and further direct my executors to make up in Money
whatever may be the difference between the Value of said Girl
& horse Saddle and Bridle and five hundred & Clark But in case
she should die before coming of age or having issue as aforesaid
the same is wholly to return into my Estate and divided
as the balance thereof is directed to be divided
by plantation wheron I live, bought of Mr. Robinson
I direct my executors to rent out annually or otherwise

either publicly or privately at their discretion. The remainder
of my estate real and personal of all kinds to be sold and the
proceeds thereof to be equally divided between my said wife
Elizabeth my son Andrew my Daughter Catherine
and the child of which my said wife is now pregnant
or the survivors of them where the children respectively be
of age. My wife to receive her part as soon as may be
convenient and I do hereby nominate and appoint Andrew
Cuff and Isaac Ellwood Esqrs. of New York and Oliver
Molland Executor of this my last will and testament
and I do hereby revoke and disannul all other or former
wills by me made and declare this and this only
to be my last will and testament in Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
my seal the day and year herein first written
Signed sealed published and declared by the testator
to be his last will and
testament and signed
by him in presence
of us who are as here
signed as witnesses thereto
