

The following wills were proved in open court and admitted to record.

In the name of God and by his permission
I James King farmer of the County of Lincoln
do make and publish this as my last will
and testament I command my soul to God
trusting that in his infinite mercy he
will receive it as his own at the great day
of resurrection. I direct that my body be in-
terred in a decent and christian like manner
at the discretion of my executor hereafter
appointed. I give to my sons William and
John King each one cow and of my stock
of cattle in full of their share of my estate
to my daughter Polly King (or alias) for her
attention and kindness to me I give sixty acres
of land including the house in which I
now live and the spring and to be reserved
to her in such manner as the discretion of
my executor (having a due regard to the balance
of the part) may direct to have the said land
to herself and her heirs in fee simple. I likewise
give to my daughter Polly a negro girl named
Debra her child Henry and her apparel in years
one horse and one beast such as she may choose
and her own saddle two cows and calves one
sow and pigs two beds and furniture (including
the one now claimed by her) and all the rest
and residue of my household and kitchen
furniture of every kind whatever Poultry and
fowl & all farming tools as well wheels born
as others except two beds and furniture
hereafter to be named disposed of I give
to my daughter Elizabeth Church one bed and
furniture to my daughter Nancy Dager
I give a bed & furniture each of

beds and furniture to be as near equal as may
be all the rest and residue of my property
both real and personal I give to my executor
and trustee upon trust first for the purpose
of paying my just debts and funeral charges
and the residue to be equally divided between
my daughters Elizabeth Barch Nancy King
& Polly King and for the purpose of more
equal distribution I hereby authorize and
empower my executor and trustee to sell the
whole or any part of the same at public
or private sale or to give to either of my
children Elizabeth Vance or Polly at fair
prices my intention is that my daughter Polly
shall have the crop growing at my decease on
my land I hereby appoint Robert H. Burton
executor & my daughter Mary King executrix
and trustee of this my will signed sealed
and published as my last will and
testament This 15th day of September 1829
In the presence of the words I give over the
eleventh line and the words following and
fulls about the 19th line interlined
before signing and the words
appointing my daughter
Polly executrix interlined
before signing.

The words "and harness saddle and all
farming tools was inserted by me in the
presence of J King and by his direction when
child Henry & his father's increase inserted in
the same manner at W B Barch 21st 1831
Robert H. Burton qualified as Executor
Mary King renounced her Executrixship
