Malinda, One bad & best & one heifer, I also bequeath to my
daughter Margaret Lin. Milham one young steer, I
also bequeath to my daughter Mary Sixty two & half
cents in money if there is any thing more or less
I will bequeath it to my son Robert. & to this my last
will & testament I do appoint & ordain John Wilson
& Alexander W. Robison, to be my lawfull executors.
