Be it known to all whom it may concern
that I Samuel Wells seal of the State of Ohio the
twentieth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred & twenty make this my last will & testament to
appoint this instrument of writing to be my
last will and testament and to have by dispensation
of my estate both real and personal in the following
manner -

I give and bequeath to my dear wife
Anna Wells my bed and bedding and all my
household furniture as private property also my
stock of horses stock and tools excepting what I
give to my Youngest Daughter Abby Wells
as hereafter directed at her marriage
with my son David I will make a new & reasonable
Saddle and bridle to her as a present
given and bequeathed to me son Samuel Wells all
my cattle except what is given off to my son
David Wells I give to my said son

Samuel Wells all the cattle belonging to him
Stock the horse mare and colt saddle also my
wife's dozen of land at her decease to descend
to my said son Samuel Wells also the half of
the stock of sheep bought of James Webb
Down belongs to said Samuel Wells the half of
give to my son David Wells the fifty acres
of land as run off to him including the house
and barn & buildings other lands to be sold

Gave him as his part, Augt Hill I give and bequeath to my daughter Peggy Wells one feather bed and furniture went two over & one over and some cloths wear. Lastly I give to my Grandson.

Elijah. Augt has the Racing Gun, sword and saddle. Lastly I give to my Grandson Elijah. You know our Country well & our long way familiar with Spring, when they usually give to all my children manifest and visible our Father each and I do hereby appoint my two Sons David & Samuel Wells Executors to this my last will and Testament. Witness where I set my hand and seal this day and date first above mentioned.
