

November 2^d 1835

In the name of god amen I Jeremiah Monday of Lincoln County North Carolina being of sound & perfect mind & memory (helped be god) do this 10th day of September in the year of our Lord 1835. Make & publish this my last will & Testament in manner following that is to say —

1st I first desire all my just debts be paid. 2^d I will bequeath unto my beloved wife Chloe during her natural life the plantation whereon I now live together with all my stock viz horses, cattle, hogs, & sheep Farming tools & household & kitchen furniture

3^d I will & bequeath at the death of wife that the plantation be sold to the highest bidder and the money be put out at interest until my youngest son Monroe become of age & then to be his also at the death of my wife all the stock & farming tools to be sold & the money to be equally divided among all my sons & sons in law, likewise the household & kitchen furniture then to be sold & the money equally divided among my four daughters. 4th I will & bequeath unto my eleven children viz seven sons & four daughters an equal part in my scrip 2250 dollars — 5th and I hereby make & ordain my well beloved son William W Monday executor of this my last will & Testament
