In the name of god whom I proclaim A Monday of
Lincoln County North Carolina being of sound & perfect
mind & memory (blessed be god) do this 10th day of September
in the year of our Lord 1835. Make & publish this my last
will & testament in manner following that is to say
1st I first desire all my just debts be paid. 2d I will
bequeath unto my beloved wife Chloe during her natural
life the plantation which I now live together with
all my stock Wag-horses, cattle, hogs, & sheep. Farming
tools & household & kitchen furniture.

3d I will & bequeath at the death of wife that the plan-
tation be sold to the highest bidder and the money
be put out at interest until my youngest son known
become of age & then to be his. also at the death of
my wife all the stock & farming tools to be sold & the
money to be equally divided among all my sons & sons
in law, likewise the household & kitchen furniture
then to be sold & the money equally divided among
my four daughters. 4th I will & bequeath unto my
seven children my seven sons & four daughters an
equal part in my scrip 2230 dollars $\frac{1}{5}$ and
I hereby make & ordain my well beloved son William
Waldridge executor of this my last will & Testament
for witness whereof I the said Jeremiah Waldridge have
to this my last will & Testament, set my hand seal
the day & year first above written
