

WILMINGTON SEPTEMBER 1801.

In the name of God Amen I John Bathay  
of the County of Lincoln & State of North Carolina  
being in perfect health & sound mind & memory  
thank God for the same, calling to mind  
the uncertainty of this life do make & ordain  
this my last Will & Testament in manner & form  
as follows. 1<sup>st</sup>. I desire that at my first death  
the funeral expenses be paid by my executors.

2d I give & bequeath to my wife Sarah my best all  
my household & kitchen glassware also all my farm  
implements also all my stock of every kind except  
as is hereafter specified also one Negro woman  
named Lucy also one negro man named Jim  
except what hereinafter specified also one straggler  
& gear, also her maintenance of the plantation  
whereon I now live during her life or widowhood.

3d I give & bequeath to my eldest daughter  
Fanny G. Bathay one horse bridle & saddle &c. that  
is to her & her bodily heirs 4th I give & bequeath  
to my second daughter Fanny clammer one dollar  
5th I also give to my eldest son James H. Bathay  
one year old colt

6th I also give & bequeath to my second son George  
H. Bathay one horse

7th I give & bequeath to my youngest son John  
H. Bathay one horse 8th I also give to my youngest  
daughter Sarah E. Bathay one horse bridle & saddle  
to her & her bodily heirs of her body

I also give to my three sons before mentioned  
all my land at my wife's death or marriage to  
be divided in the following manner. Those of  
my sons that get a trade, each have one part &  
those that yet have no trade two parts of all get trade

them to be now in evident failing of health  
I also give to you my son & daughter as my  
managers under my direction in my minority  
years. Also all my other property bequeath to my  
wife at her discretion as a widow. I directed my wife  
all my children except my daughter Maria Murray  
to be my executors that she do best execute my will &  
trust after the death of me husband & my daughter  
also all my property left remaining in my wife to her  
sole & undivided according to the terms annexed  
also I appoint my beloved wife Maria Murray and  
James H. Farley sole executors of my last will  
& Testament in witness whereof I have signed to  
set my hand and seal this day of the year  
of our Lord
