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In the Name of God Amen I give in Presence
of the County of Lincolnshire of Lincashire being
weak of body & of perfect mind & memory thankes
the grace of God calling unto Mind the Mortality
of my body & knowing that it is apponited for all
Mens once to die, do make and Ordaine this my
last will & Testament, that is to say first principall
by Spirit of all, I give & Bequeath my soul
into the hands of Almighty God, that gave it
of my body I remeke to the Earth to be buried
in a decent Christian burial at the
discretion of my Executor, and as touching
such worldly Estate, wherewith it hath pleased
God to bless me in this life, I give and devise
disposse of the same in the following manner
and form, After my funeral expenses and
debts are paid I give and bequeath to Joseph
Dellinger, my beloved Son all my Estate both
real & personal. And I do hereby utterly dis-
allow, revoke and disannull all & every other
will, testamet & confirme this to be my last will
& Testament. And I appoint my Son Joseph
Dellinger Executor of this my last will &
testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand & seal this Twentyfifth day of
January in the Year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred & eleven years two.
