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In the name of our Lord Amen I, John Dellenor
of the County of Lincoln State of Indiana being
weak of body & of perfect mind & memory hereby
do give unto God calling unto mind the mortality
of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all
men once to die, do make and ordain this my
last will & testament, that is to say ~~first~~ principal
ly & first of all, I give & recommend my soul
into the hands of Allmighty God that gave it
& my body I recommend to the Earth to be bur-
ied in a decent christian burial at the
discretion of my Executors, and as touching
such worldly Estate, wherewith it hath pleased
God to bless me in this life, I give and devise
& dispose of the same in the following manner
and form, After my funeral expenses and
debts are paid I give and bequeath to Joseph
Dellenor, my beloved son all my Estate both
real & personal. And I do hereby utterly dis-
allow, revoke and disannul all & every other
will & testify & confirm this to be my last will
& testament. And I appoint my son Joseph
Dellenor Executor of this my last will & tes-
tament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand & Seal this Twentieth day of
January in the Year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred & twenty ~~two~~ two.
