Do this 3rd day of April in the Year of our Lord
1827 make and publish this my last will &
Testament in the manner following that is to say
1st I recommend my Soul to God who gave
it, & my Body to be interred in a Christian like
Manner, thinking, that it is appointed for all men
Once to depart this life, hoping still that at
the last day I shall be raised up with him
in Glory who is Lord of Lords & King of Kings,
2nd I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife
Abigail Endersby the whole of my ^{real} Estate, Except
as herein after mentioned, and my Negro man
Allen and my negroe Girl Juliana
two horned creatures, her Choice of my Stock, one
Saddle & Bridle, all my flock of Cattle, except
as herein after mentioned, all my sheep & Eight
head of Hogs, her Choice of the Stock,
my Waggons & Pares all my Farming Tools
and implements of every description, & belonging
to the farm, all the household & Kitchen furniture
of every description, & all my Bedsteads & Bedding
Crop, Grass, her wheels, cart & Carriage, leather & all
my Books to be for her use & am. & mine during
her lifetime or wid. or hord, at either of the Before
mentioned Periods, all the above mentioned property
or what remains thereof to be sold & equally divided
between my eight children & my negros
above named excepted

should marry, I allow her an equal part
with the above named children.

The said negroes above named to belong to my
son William Endersley at my wife's death or
changing her way of living.

3rd I give & bequeath unto my son John Endersley
One hundred acres of Land that I bought of
John Dunlap, & of the Charles Thompson
& of the fifty acres of Land out of a tract of Black
granted by patent to John Endersley, & dated
the 13th October 1783 of the South side of
said tract along the first line a long square
from the second till the fourth line of said tract.

4th I give & Bequeath unto my son James
Endersley my Cloath and the balance of my Stock
to be equally divided between the said James
& my son John Endersley.

5th I give and bequeath unto my Daughter
that is, Jean Endersley fifty six Dollars & two Cents
out of my Stock, or the Value thereof, Martha Endersley
fifty six Dollars & two Cents out of my Stock &
a side Saddle or the Value thereof, Elizabeth
Endersley fifty six Dollars, two Cents out of my
Stock & a side Saddle or the Value thereof,
Deborah Endersley fifty six Dollars, two Cents
out of my Stock and a side Saddle, or the
Value thereof, the Saddles to be of a good
quality.

I also give and Bequeath to my daughters
Martha, Elizabeth, & Deborah Endsley
Each a flay spinning wheel the above named
Money & I desire not to come out of my stock
of cattle,

To the I give & bequeath unto my wife, ^{Beloved} Deborah
Endsley, One hundred Dollars in money
& the remainder of the tract of Land that I sold
to Philip Craft to be sold at One Dollar
per acre, this & the Balance of my money &
property not heretofore disposed of to be equally
divided ^{amongst} my nine children, James Endsley,

Sarah Endsley, Mary Endsley, John Endsley,
Jean Endsley, Martha Endsley, Elizabeth Endsley,
William Endsley, Deborah Endsley & I hereby
Ordain my Beloved wife Deborah ^{Endsley} & my son
James Endsley, & my son in law Jas. McFarland
Executors of this my Last will & last amendment
