I John Glenn of the County of Lincoln and State of North Carolina
Being of sound mind and memory. But considering, uncertainty of
my earthly existence. do make and declare this my last will and
testament in manner and form following that is to say, First that
my executor hereafter named shall provide for my decent burial
according to the wishes of my just debts, however and to whomsoever
owing out of the moneys that may first come to hand as a part of

my estate
I give and devise to my beloved wife the tract of land
on which I now live, and all my loose property and stock of every
kind her natural life or widowhood, and at her death or marriage
these my moneys shall be divided equally between my son Samuel R. P. Glenn and my daughter
Nancy Adeline Glenn
My will is that my son Samuel R. P. Glenn shall have twenty five dollars in money
and my daughter Nancy Adeline Glenn shall have twenty five dollars in money
My son Samuel R. P. Glenn shall have all my

my thing then remains that there shall be an Equal

My will is if anything then remains that there shall be an Equal
division between all my children that is living)

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty friend
R. R. Summey my lawful Executor to all intents and purposes to
execute this my last will and testament according to the true
intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause thereof
truly looking and declaring utterly void all other wills and testaments
by me heretofore made. In Witness whereof I the said John
Glenn do hereunto set my hand and seal this 31st day of January
1858.
