

The following will was presented in Open Court & admitted to record

In the name of God Amen
I John Huffmann of the County of Nevada, State of
Nevada having been seized with some in
mind & memory but calling to mind that it is
appointed for all men once to die do by these presents
make this & that only my last will & testament
first I recommend my soul to God who gave it
my body to the earth to from whence it came
to be buried in a decent funeral the direction of
my Executors hereafter appointed
I will & bequeath to my son John Huffmann
all the land I hold or own on the North side of the creek
on which I now live including mill, mill pond
I further will unto him my negro Buyamini
I further will to my son Joseph Huffmann all the
land I own on the South side of said creek, Long creek,
including the improvement on which he now lives,
the Eliza Whady place & the Sumby four acre
tract called the Mills place
I further will & dispose of my lands on the South
side of the South fork of the Tatallba River
including the mill & improvement called the Long
Huffmann mill & the Hammitt place or where
John Hammitt lives & including the little place
where Golly Harris lives in short all the land I
own down there on said fork to be divided between
my son John Huffmann & the Six Sons of my
son John viz. Eli, Michael, Isaac, Simon, Abel,
& John in full and a division here to commence
at the mouth of a branch called the coll branch
I do run up the said branch to its head then a
straight line nearly parallel to the old Patent line
where it crosses a deep hollow then all on the
side of said line next to Thomas Hammitt land
I will & bequeath to my son John Huffmann
& that part on the other side of said line I will
& bequeath unto the said Six Sons of my
son John Huffmann viz. Eli &
