North Carolina Lincoln County

We the undersigned Samuel Knox, William Reids, do hereby certify that I John Knox late decedent of this County in our presence & to us did declare and say the following to be his will & wish in disposing of his Estate - viz - First he allows his beloved wife Hannah all such articles as she thinks she needs - secondly he allows his negro Boy Jim to be sold to discharge the debt contracted in purchasing him - Third he allows his negro girl Milly & Chere to be hired out until all his debts are paid. Fourth he allows his land to be rented until his debts are all paid - Fifth he allows all the balance of his property to be sold & after all his just debts are paid he allows his beloved wife Hannah & the Child she is now pregnant with if a living Child to be equal sharers of his whole Estate Sixth he allows his brother James B. Knox to be the sole Executor of his Estate whereunto we set our hands and seals this 25th November A.D. 1829
