and admitted to Record (123)

In the name of God Amen I John Singsfett
of the County of Lincoln and State of North Carolina
Being of perfect Mind and Memory (Blessed be God)
do this 14th day of May in the Year of our Lord 1837
Make and publish this my last will and testament
in manner following, that is to say, First, I give & bequeath
to each of my ^{two} Daughters Anna & Elizabeth Sixty Dollars
Second I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sally &
her Children five half of Cattle which she has now
in her possession, Third and the remainder shall be
divided in eight equal shares to my daughters that is to say,
Anna & Elizabeth 1/8th, Barbara 1/8th, Molly 1/8th,
Katherine 1/8th, Fanny 1/8th, Eve 1/8th & Sally 1/8th and I
make and ordain my beloved Son Jacob Singsfett
Executor of this my last will and testament In witness
whereof I John Singsfett have set to this my last will
and testament my hand and Seal the day and Year
above written Signed Sealed published and declared
by the said John Singsfett in presence of us who
were present at the time of signing and sealing thereof
