In the Name of God I John Singefell of the County of Lincoln and State of North Carolina & Being of perfect Mind and Memory (before God) do this 14<sup>th</sup> day of May in the Year of our Lord 1829 Make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner following, that is to say, first, I give & bequeath to each of my two daughters Anna & Elizabeth Sixty Dollars Second I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sally Jones her Children five head of cattle which she has now in her possession, third and the remainder shall be divided in eight equal shares to the daughters that are said, Anna & Elizabeth 1/8<sup>th</sup>, Barbara 1/8<sup>th</sup>, Molly 1/8<sup>th</sup>, Catherine 1/8<sup>th</sup>, Fanny 1/8<sup>th</sup>, Eve 1/8<sup>th</sup> & Sally 1/8<sup>th</sup> and make and ordain my beloved Son Jacob Singefell Executor of this my last will and Testament In witness whereof I John Singefell have set to this my last will and Testament my hand and Seal the day and year above written Signed Sealed published and declared by the said John Singefell in presence of us who were present at the time of signing and sealing thereof
