John Miller of the County of Lincoln & State
of North Carolina being of sound & perfect
mind and memory do hereby bequeath the first
day the 17th of May in the year 1835 to our loved son
Thousand Eight Hundred & Twenty four. And in
publish this my last will & Testament in
manner following that is to say

First I give & bequeath to my beloved wife
Barbara to keep all the property & the whole
estate in her care until her death.

Second After my beloved wife's death I
want my lawful heirs to have an equal part of
my estate and if they should all be of their
age I want them to divide the property
amongst themselves and if they are not all of
age the property then to be sold & if they can
not agree in dividing the property amongst them-
selves then I want their good friends to
divide it for them and I hereby make and
ordain my worthy son John Miller Executor
of this my last will & Testament In witness
whereof I the said John Miller have to this my
last will & Testament. Set my hand & seal the
day & year first above written
