the weak in body, do make, ordain & constitute appoint
this instrument of writing to be my last will & testament
God hereby directed & instructed all my will, I declare
this & this only to be my last Will & Testament & as a part
of my Estate as follows

1st I will & allow my funeral & expenses to be paid

2^d I will & allow my just debts to be paid

3^d I will & allow my watch to Hugh Torrance's daughter Polly

4th I will & allow my gun to Hugh Torrance's daughter Polly

5th I will & allow ten dollars to John Torrance's daughter Polly

6th I will and allow the balance of my Estate to Hugh

Torrance. Signed, sealed and delivered in the presence

of — This 6th day of August 1828
