Jonas Rhymes Will

In the name of God Amen I Jonas Rhyme of the above County & State being of sound mind and memory and considering the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof to the end that I may be the better prepared to leave this world. when it may please God to call me hence have now determined to direct what disposition shall be made of my property after my decease and after mentally considering the circumstances and condition of all those among whom as my heirs at Law or the objects of my gratitude or affection in my judgment. my Estate shall be distributed, I do make publish and declare this to be my last will & testament hereby revoking all others null & void My will is first that after my decease. my body shall be decently buried without ostentation or unnecessary expence and that my funeral charges and just debts shall be paid by my Executor herein named. — I give and devise unto my wife Anney the Possession of my Dwelling house & Kitchen during her natural life and after her death. My will is that all my Daughters that may remain single & unmarried to retain the poss. of the dwelling house & Kitchen so long as they remain unmarried. though I have sold me Land to my son Jonas Rhyme but with the residue of the

and after her death. My Will is that all my Daughters that may remain single & unmarried to retain the possession of the dwelling house & kitchen so long as they remain unmarried. though I have sold my Land to my son Jones Rhine Jun. with the reserve of the dwelling house & kitchen during my wife Annys life time. Item 2^d. My Will further is that my Stock of Horses Cattle Hogs and all other Stock of every kind besides my Waggon & Carriage & farming utensils of all descriptions to Remain on the place for the benefit of the family or those of them that may be unmarried you also all of the grain of all kind at my death besides the Threshing Machine and all of my property of every kind to remain on the place until her death or the marriage of my daughter. I further order that my Spinning Machine remain for the benefit of my daughter so long as they remain single or unmarried. Item 3^d My Will further is after the death of my wife Anny & the Marriage of my Daughters then and in that case I order that all of the property on hand shall be sold by my Executors herein named & Equally divided between all of my Daughters Mary Rhine Peggy Rhine Sarah Rhine Polly Rhine & Eliza Rhine. I do hereby nominate and appoint my son Jones Rhine & my son John Rhine as my sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament. Whereunto I set my hand and seal this the 1st day of June 1837. in presence of
