one half to my son Ellison & the other half
to my daughter Jenny C. Stone & he and also Rose's
youngest child not yet named is my daughter
Jenny C. Stone then I bequeath to my son
James Clark Gullick my negro girl named
Mary & bequeath at my wife's death then I
bequeath to my son Ellison Green above Gullick
the plantation & tract of land & now live
on also my negro man named Ned my
negro boy named Jim my negro boy
named Andy and my negro girl

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namd Jean also all my horses cattle hogs waggon
 & years & all things thousands appertaining also
 all my farming land mechanical tools & imple-
 ments also my clock & case & one bed & furniture
 & one walnut table also bedstead clock & Geography
 & my account Book & my best Bible
 all the remainder of my books & all to be
 as equally divided between my wife & children
 as convenient. Item it is my will that my
 wife Margaret have all the remaining part
 of my Estate not above willed or bequeathed
 to dispose of at her discretion. Item I do hereby
 constitute and appoint my much respected
 friend Oliver Holland and my son
 Abner Holland my whole & sole Executors
