I Joshua Nixon of the State and County above written, being in a low state of health of body but of sound disposing mind, being desirous of disposing of estate do make this my last will and Testament

Item 1st I will that my Funeral expenses and all my just debts be paid out of my Estate

Item 2nd I will and bequeath unto my beloved wife Petty Nixon all my Estate both real and personal during her natural life or widowhood: and my will is that she divide an apportion off to each of my beloved children Eliza Bartlett, Susan Lawrence, Albert Hoady and George whom they become of age or marry, such a portion of my Estate both real and personal as she may think proper so that in the final division of my Estate: which shall take place at the death of my wife or termination

I Joshua Nixon of the State and County above written, being in a feeble state of health, of bodily but of sound disposing mind, being desirous of disposing of estate do make this my last will and testament.

Item 1st I will that my funeral expenses and all my just debts be paid out of my estate.

Item 2nd I will and bequeath unto my beloved wife Petty Nixon all my Estate both real and personal during her natural life or widowhood: and my will is that she divide an apportion off to each of my beloved children Eliza Bartlett, Susan Larivine, Albert Hoady and James. When they become of age or marry, such a portion of my Estate both real and personal as she may think proper so that in the final division of my Estate: which shall take place at the death of my wife or termination of her widowhood. Each of my beloved children above named shall have an equal divide of all my property. My will further is that my wife

Petty have the right and it is authorized by this my last will and testament if she thinks proper to sell or dispose of all my real property as she may think proper so that the account to each of my children for their distribution share of said property in the final division of my estate. And my will further is that if my wife Petty should marry that all my property both real and personal be equally divided between my wife and children.

Item 3rd I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Petty sole Executrix of this my last will and testament.
