In the name of God Amen. I Joseph Sherrill of the
County of Lincoln State of North Carolina Being of sound
minded & perfect memory before me be body do on this 17th
day of March in the year of one thousand thousand eight
hundred & thirty one make & publish this to be my
last will & testament in manner & form as follows that
I do will & bequeath unto my beloved wife Nancy during
her life time no greater sum of money or goods to be sold
& given also one third part of my effects of lands & other
deaths my will is that said effects be first & last divided
the effects to be equally divided among my wife
children, And the following property I give & bequeath
unto her for her own disposal my two bay horses But that
two cows I leave one three year old heifer & her choice
of one of my slaves also half of my stock of hogs in kind
& a large plough two pair of oxen & half of all the balance
of my farming tools & half of all grain provided
whatever that may be on hand at my decease also
half of all the grain &c that may be growing.
Also all my household & kitchen furniture & except
my bed & black furniture from these part of the
Kitchen furniture which it is furtherwise bequeathed
by & given & bequeath unto my daughter Ruth my negro
girl Petrus 3rd & give I bequeath unto my son Little my
negro boy Cline 4th & give I bequeath unto my son Tom
Black my negro man Cline 5th & give I bequeath unto
my son Eli my tract of land & of land thereon Negro
by four hundred feet to those already gave him as
will appear from Bill of Sale.

Also one book of furniture & bed & bed stand & one chair part
of my kitchen furniture. & all the farming tools, etc., etc.
which is bequeathed to my wife also my wagon & team
of my Dell & Gray mules, & three mare. I will also leave
of my live stock of 4 mares three year old, half of
my stock of hogs also one half of all the grain
provisions I possessing together with half of the grain
etc. that may be growing on the plantation at my decease,
Also my further intent is that the said goods, & money belonging
shall by my executors as soon they may do so be admissible
for the benefit of my daughter Agnes to put the said negro
girl to private tutorage to serve the stipulated period. The pay
of the said girl to be by them paid up in installments
referred in the said sum to be annually paid unto my
said daughter until she through infirm, etc. shall require
more for her comfortable maintenance. Then you thus cause
they may annually pay such portion of the said sum
as may be thought by them necessary or convenient, & so happen
that she may become a widow my will is that they pay
to her the whole remaining balance or should she die
the balance of the said sum is to be equally
divided between her heirs as they may become of age \$5.
My will I bequeath unto my daughter Rosemary my
young girl Rebecca & further all the household property
with it among the one half of my family books & writing
books & the other half of said Books
My further will is that all my property not herebefore
named shall be put to sale & after paying all my just
debts the balance to be equally divided among my
natural heirs for their more convenience my executors
place before the returning fall my will is that no
division of my property be made to be placed before
fall. further what cotton etc. is now growing
shall be left to the use of the family
I do hereby appoint Rosemary my surviving wife
Michael Sherman & Robert Black her executors
of this my last will & testament for writing where

in the property thereof during her lifetime or widowhood
to live in said lands of the said property during her natural
life & after her decease I will that the said fifty acres of
land shall belong to my son Joseph C. Person likewise
I will hereinafter my son Joseph C. Person a certain
 negro my married fortune after my decease to be his an
 forever also my wearing apparel & working tools likewise
the rest of my family will I will hereinafter to be left
Person or certain negro woman named Phyllis to be
my slave after my decease given by me to said Phyllis attorney to
son Patrick Burke a certain negro woman whom I give to
to his wife forever likewise will to the said Patrick Burke my self
approximately the balance of my property after my debts & funeral
charges are paid & will that the rest be divided between my son
Joseph C. Person & his wife Elizabeth equally I do hereby appoint & nominate
Joseph C. Person & his wife Elizabeth Esq's of this my last will & Testament
doth determine to make all other wills or testaments whatsoever
in writing which I the said John Person have heretofore
set my hand & affix my seal this 25 day of June
