

In the name of God Amen, I Lafayette Wilson do make
publish and declare the following to be my last Will and
Testament as follows; I direct that my debts be paid, and
the remainder of my estate I dispose of in the following
manner that is to say, I give Will and devise all my Estate
Real and personal to my wife and Children, to be kept by
my wife and not to be sold except as she may think nec-
essary for the support of herself and family, until my oldest
Child shall arrive at the age of Twenty one years, and then my
wife must give said Child an Equal share of my Estate.
That is one fourth part: if my wife has but three Children,
and then as each Child becomes of age the said Child shall
receive from my wife one share, that is my Estate is given
to my wife and Children equally share & share alike. But
my Children are not to receive their part of my Estate until
they each arrive at the age of twenty one years. My
Estate is left with my wife until my Children arrive at
age for the purpose of enabling her to support and take
care of my Children

I hereby appoint my wife Susan E. Wilson Executrix
of this my last Will & Testament
