I Lewis Street of the County of Lincoln
& State of North Carolina am sick a long
but of sound Mind & Perfect Memory and under-
standing do make & publish this my last Will
& Testament in the following manner to wit
I recommend my soul into the hands of god
my body to be buried in a Christian manner
And as touching such worldly estate wherewith
it hath pleased god to bless me in
this life I ordain that all my just debts
to be paid out of my estate and I give devise
& dispose of the same in the following man-
ner to wit I give & bequeath to my dear
beloved Wife Margaret I give the plantation
I now live on during her life, two Cows
& two Sows, one Saddle two head of Horses
the black Horse & the mare, a brass kettle two
beds & steady two tables half doz Chairs, an armoire
& all that on it is two head of Sheep one wheel,
one Reel & the loom & all the gears two pe
horse gears & two plows & one Waggon one
chest, one hundred Bushels corn the Crop
now growing forty Bushels wheat one pot
one Dutch oven & pan, all the Cotton & flax
five hogs to kill for my wife. And to my
son David Street my right in the plantation
that he now lives on & three acres off my
Meadow the lower part of the Meadow
And to my son Solomon I will fifty dollars
in Money. To my son Dawson I will
seventy dollars in Money. And to my son

November 23rd 1835

Moses Monroe. I will the plantation I now
live on at his Mother's death. And I will
to my Eldest Daughter Catharine one hundred
dollars in Money. I will to my daughter Day
one hundred & fifty dollars in Money. —
I will to my daughter Sally one hundred & fifty
dollars in Money. — one barrel two Cow, one wash
pot & Cooking pot. Also a Dutch oven one pair of
two lead & steady one side saddle one chest one
sherp. And all the over plus if any to be
equally divided among all my children. And
I also do hereby constitute, make & ordain my
son Joseph Huet my sole executor to this my
last Will & Testament. and I do hereby utterly
disallow, revoke & disannul all & every former
Will, & Testaments. ~~Repealing~~ & Confirming this
& no other, to be my last Will & Testament.

hand & affixed my seal this 15th day August
in the year of our Lord 1835
