Margret Sebocke's will

In the name of God Amen. I Margret Sebocke of Lincoln County and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory and understanding, but considering the mortality of this life think fit, to make this my last will and testament in the following manner viz - I recommend my soul into the hand of Almighty God and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian manner at the direction of my Executor Ad. Touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner: First of all it is my will and desire that out of my estate my beloved daughter Mary is to have the following property to viz. one loom and all that belongs to it one big wheel stool, one bread-tray one pot & rack one skillet one coffee mill and brass coffee kettle one lath & skimmer, one bucket one churn one putter dish one deep putter dish some set of putter plates one set of putter spoons, all the knives, forks, Iron & German Bible, all the bed clothing. Some except one kimlet one shirt & three pillow slips, 2 hogg. first choice, 2 sheep first choice, one cow and all the mutton on hand, all the wheat on hand, all the sheep on hand all my salt at home and that I lent out, 2 sitting chairs, all my crop of corn & garden

Secondly I will and bequeath unto Elizabeth Mahaly daughter one kinslet one shut and

 of my property is to be sold and equally divided
 between all my children: by my Executor - I do also
 constitute make and ordain my beloved son
 Lejune Bullinger to be my Executor of this my last
 will and testament, and I do hereby utterly disavow
 revoke disannul all and every other former
 wills and testaments legacies and bequests before
 named and made ratifying and confirming
 that this and no other to be my last will
 and testament, In witness whereof I have here-
 unto set my hand and seal This 25th day
 of July A.D. 1843
