In the name of God the Father. I Margaret Strock of Lincoln County and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory and understanding, but considering the Mortality of this life think fit to make this my last will and testament in the following manner viz - I recommend my soul into the hand of Almighty God and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my Executor. Regarding such worldly estate wherewithal it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner: First of all it is my will and desire that out of my estate my beloved daughter Mary is to have the following property to viz. one loom and all that belongs to it one big wheel & nail, one bread-tray one pot & rack one skillet one coffee mill and brass coffee kettle one leather skinning, one basket one churn one butter dish one deep butter dish four set of plates four set of plates Spoons, all the knives & forks, four German Bibles, all the bed clothing I own except one kinlet one sheet & three pillow slips, 2 huff. first choice, 2 sheep first choice, one cow and all the infants on hand, all the wheat on hand, all the sheep wool on hand all my salt at home and that I sent out, 2 setting chairs, all my crop of corn & garden

oats on hand all my salt at home and that I  
left out, 2 setting chairs, all my crop of corn & garden  
vegetables now growing, all the cotton and wool on  
hand all my crockery ware, one pair of fine tongs  
and shovel, I heartily will and bequeath unto  
Ezra Mahaly with one couchit one sheet and

true full power, I hereby it is will that all the rest  
 of my property is to be sold and equally divided  
 between all my children by my Executor - I do also  
 constitute make and ordain my beloved son  
 George Bullinger to be my Executor of this my last  
 will and testament, and I do hereby utterly disallow  
 make disavow all and every other former  
 wills and testaments legacies and bequests before  
 named and made ratifying and confirming  
 that this and no other to be my last will  
 and testament, witness whereof I have here-  
 unto set my hand and seal this 25<sup>th</sup> day  
 of July A.D. 1843
