I Margaret Vanduyke being in a weak state
of health but of sound mind & memory do make
& publish the following to be my last will &
Testament. In the first place I wish my body
to be buried in a decent Christian like manner
In the 2nd place I give & bequeath to my daughter
Sarah Caring my Negro woman named Liza
& her child. Among her natural life & after her
death the said Negro woman & her increase
(if living) to go the Children of my said daughter
to be equally divided amongst them by sale
or otherwise than I shall think fit. This Negro
woman & her child I value to my said

Daughter at \$700. In the 3rd place I give & bequeath to my son Lewis Vandeyke of all money due to me or a sum of money equal to the value I have set upon said negro woman & child and if there should be any money over & above that due to me I will & desire it to be equally divided between my said children. My wearing apparel I give to my said daughter and my bed & furniture I wish should be equally divided between my said children but if they cannot agree about the division it to be sold & the money arising therefrom to be equally divided between them.

I do hereby appoint my trusty friend Robert Williamson the Executor of this my last will & Testament
