I, the Name of Rod Atwell
& imploring divine direction & blessing to accompany
this solemn work of setting my hand in order before I die
I widow Mary Ferguson living on the head waters
of Crowder Creek Lincoln County North Carolina
being in a declining state of health - bid of perfect
Mind memory & judgment (thank the Almighty God)
& knowing that it is appointed for all - once to die
do make and give this my last will & testament
in the following manner & form - that is to say after
Committing my soul ^{to God} who gave it & my body to the earth
to be buried in a Christian like manner, I leave my
last debts & funeral expences to be paid out of the whole
& as to any worldly property wherewithal I have pleased
My heavenly benefactor to favour me I give devise &
bequeath it in the manner & form following first I leave
& bequeath to my Grandson Alfred Hale Ferguson son to
George W Ferguson all that tract & parcel of land I now
own & possess containing about two hundred acres to the
same more or less bounded by the speculated land,
William Love & John Ferguson Land, to said Alfred
H Ferguson his heirs & assigns for ever with all rights
members & appertaining thereto belonging also I leave
& bequeath to my Grand daughter Mary Eliza Ferguson
daughter to George W Ferguson all personal property
which I own viz a horse, Cow, sheep, Hogs etc
with every article I now own except as is here excepted
to my daughter Mary Ann Neil I leave & bequeath my
bed & bed furniture & all my clothing, Chair and
Chair & spinning wheel & to my other children viz

Thomas, Robert, James William Andrew, John & George Ferguson I leave & bequeath to each of them one
hundred sterling (if demanded) to cut them off from any
claim they might make considering that each of them
has already received their part & for the just & full execu-
tion of this my last will & testament.

I nominate and appoint William McGill Esq &
My son George W^r Ferguson the Ex^rremaining
any other will or wills heretofore made by me
In Testimony whereof I do hereunto set my hand and
affix My seal this 25 day of August in the year of
Our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty five
Signed sealed & acknowledged ^{her} Mary X Ferguson (Seal)
