In the name of God Amen, I Mary Gannoy of
Lincoln County in the State of North Carolina being weak
in body though of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God
for the same and calling to mind the mortality of my body
& that it is appointed unto all men to die, I do make & ordain
this my last will and testament recommending my soul
to God who gave it to me and my body to the earth to be
buried with a decent burial at the discretion of my executor
hereafter named and as for what worldly estate it hath
pleased God to bestow upon me, I give devise & bequeath
& dispose of the same in the following manner in the
first I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sabella
One Dollar, ^{I bequeath} second to my daughter Sarah one dollar,
also to my Daughter Finney one Dollar, also to my
Daughter Mary One dollar, also to my Daughter
Martha one dollar, also to my Daughter Nancy one
Dollar, and all the balance of my estate to be
equally divided between my other two Daughters viz
Margaret & Cal. Lastly I do appoint John Hall Executor
and I do hereby Revoke all other wills by me made
And I do hereby Ratify & Confirm this & this only to be
my last will & testament to my Children in Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and caused my
seals to be affixed this fifteenth day of July in the
Year of our Lord one ^{thousand} eight hundred & twenty six
signed sealed & delivered published pronounced
& declared by the said Mary Gannoy the testator
as her last will
