2nd

I Allow all my just debts to be paid for which
purpose I allow a sale to be made of such part of my stock
of Cattle & other property that can be best applied
to the amount of said Debts & expenses of Burial

3rd All property that I possess both real & personal at
the time of my decease besides what will pay my debts I give
and bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth
Gaultney during her life

4th After my wife's decease I give ^{& bequeath} unto my daughter Mary
Gaultney & the said Gaultney the plantation whereon I now
live with all other the personal property she may have
at that time share & share alike to be equally divided
between them. 5th The Girl named Michely Gaultney born to
me on her arriving at age I allow her to have the dower agreed
upon out of my estate

6th I do hereby nominate & appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth Gaultney
& Joseph Graham as executors of this my last Will & testament
In testimony whereof I the said Nathan Gaultney have hereunto
set my hand & seal this 17th day of January in the year of our Lord
1784 signed sealed & pronounced by Nathan Gaultney to be his last
will & testament & signed by him in the presence of us
each other
