 followeth. that is to say. I give and bequeath unto my wife Sarah
 after paying my just debts and funeral expences all my
 Real and Personal Estate during her life time and after
 her death I allow the plantation which I now live for Nicholas &
 In Her all. I allow the Stoffel place or Callen for Septial
 Tucker I allow also unto John W. Tucker all the money that is
 coming to me in Pennsylvania of the estate of John W. Tucker
 and I allow also one hundred Dollars to Eliza Tucker and I
 also allow fifty Dollars unto Grizzell Bartley and the rest of
 my Property to be disposed of as my wife Sarah thinks proper.
 And I do hereby appoint my true and worthy friend John Tucker
 the Executor of this my last Will and Testament as Witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 26th August 1817
