 Make and publish this my last will
 and Testament in manner following
 that is to say, first I give and bequeath

 the improvements thereon he now
 lives, on the Waters of Muddy fork
 Except, as hereafter mentioned, Second
 I give and bequeath unto my daughters
 Sarah Dellinger, wife of Jacob Dellinger
 Polly Dellinger, wife of Frederick Dellin-
 ger, Miriana Dellinger, now wife of
 Houser, Pransah Hannel Dellinger, -
 Margaret Sophia Dellinger Barbara

 land that I now own on the Waters

smoking iron, one set of plates two dishes
to each of them. Fourth I give and bequeath
unto my son Daniel H. Delling, the
plantation whereon I now live and all
that adjoining, on the Waters of Indian
creek. Except as here of be mentioned and
also one cow and calf, one bedstead
and bedding. Fifth I give and bequeath
unto my beloved Wife Margaret
Delling all the land that I now own
on the Waters of Indian creek and
Muddy fork as long as she lives and
Remains unmarried, for her support and
the family and also all my personal property
Except what is here of be mentioned of every
name kind, and description all my house
hold and kitchen furniture of every name
kind and description whatsoever during her
natural life time or widow hood.

Sophia Dillingers, Barbara Neakies Dillingers
Marion Dillingers, now wife of Elias Howser
Sarah Dillingers, wife of Jacob Dillingers,
Polly Dillingers, wife of Frederick Dillingers,

all the personal property that is left upon
the death or Widowhood of my beloved wife
Margaret Dellenger, to be equally divided
Between them the girls part to belong to them
and the half of their own body.

A lastly I give and bequeath unto my
beloved wife Margaret Dellenger, all my
money notes and accounts, and all my
clothing during her lifetime or remains
a Widow, and in case she should marry
to have a childer part, out of all my person-
al property, and I hereby make and
ordain my sons George Dellenger, and
Samuel^d Dellenger Executors of this my last
Will and Testament, in Witness whereof
