Carolina and County of Lincoln being
of sound mind and perfect memory but
considering my earthly existence un-
certain do make and declare this to be
my last will and testament I will moreover
and for the following that is to say
first that my executors herein after
named provide for my body a decent
burial suitable to the wishes of my friends
do and relatives and pay all funeral ex-
penses to gether with all my just debts
to unknown and however owing on my
the first money that may come into
their hands as a part or parcel of my
estate

(then) I give and bequeath to my well
beloved wife Lydia all the plantation
whereon I now live during her widow-
hood if in case she should marry a-
gain from the part of said plantation
lying on the East side of the branch run-
ning from Schencks old field into Sandies
mill creek that part whereon David

of Sound Mind and perfect Memory but
Considering my Earthly Existence un-
certain do make and declare this to be
My Last will and Testament I in manner
and form following that is to say
first that my Executors hereinafter
named provide for my body a decent
Burial Suitable to the wishes of my friends
and relatives and pay all funeral ex-
pences to gether with all my just debts
for whom and however owing out of
the first money that may come into
their hands as a part or parcel of my
Estate

Item) I give and bequeath to my well
beloved wife Lydia all the plantation
whereon I now live during her widow-
hood if in case she should marry a-
gain from the part of said plantation
lying on the East side of the branch run-
ning from Schencks old mill into Canfield
mill creek that part whereon David
Haus built his house to let him live there
and he to pay her one fifth of all her re-
nts as it she desires it off of said land during
her widow hood but if she marries

then it is to stop I also give her one
milk cow & calf one breeding sow and
pigs all my house hold and kitchen
furniture, if she chooses our young man-
servant for her and family out of my
staffs or friends if I have sufficient if
not my executor to buy what lacks to be
paid off by Joseph Deonhardt, Peter Hoke
and Elijah Sullivan To be hers absolutely for
ever in fee simple

(Item) I give to my Son David Haup
one half of my plantation to be equally
divided into two tracts the old field to be
divided with the wood land so as to make
them of equal valuation the title not
to come to him until after my wife's
death or marriage in case she should
marry and at the time he gets possession
is to pay to my four daughters the sum
of Two hundred dollars to be equally di-
vided between Eliza, Nancy, Mary and
Barbary & that he live on that portion

(Item) I give to my son David Flaus
one half of my plantation to be equally

to come to him until after my wife's
death or marriage in case she should
marry and at the time he gets possession
is to pay to my four daughters the sum
of Two hundred dollars to be equally di-
vided between Elizay, Nancy, Mary and
Barbara & that he live on that portion
of land wherein he built his house as the
half intended for him is to include his
improvements

(Item) I give to Son Andrew Flaus the
other half of my plantation to get pos-
session after my wife's death and on getting
possession he is to pay the sum of two hu-
ndred dollars to be also divided equally between
my four Daughters as Elizay, Nancy, Mary,

Parkway as a part of their legacy
Many I give & bequeath to my Son Peter Hamps
Ten dollars which with a small advancement
and giving the time to learn a trade make
him an equal share with the rest.

I Item, I give and bequeath to my Son Peter
Hamps fifty dollars and he learn a trade of
eighteen which will make him equal with
the rest of my children.

And the rest of my property not herein
bequeathed to be sold by my Executors here in
after named and after paying such portions
to each as I direct the over plus to be de-
vided equally among my four daughters as
their portion of my estate.

Lastly, I appoint my trusty friends Joseph
Hansen and George Brown my lawful Executors
to execute this my last will and testament
now closing & sealing to void all other wills by me
here to fore made and that they shall execute said
will according to the true intent and meaning
of the same.

I Item, I give and bequeath to my son John Rufus fifty dollars and his choice a trade of eighteen which will make him equal with the rest of my children.

And ^{all} the rest of my property not herein bequeathed to be sold by my executors herein after named and after paying such portions to each as I direct the over plus to be divided equally among my four daughters as their portion of my estate.

Lastly, I appoint my trusty friends Joseph Hauser and George Boon my lawful Executors to execute this my last will and testament revoking & setting aside all other wills by me here to fore made and that they shall execute said will according to the true intent and meaning of the same.
