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hould and kitchen furniture, and farming tools and all kind of stock on hand at my death my wife Mary Reep and my two daughters Elizabeth Reep & Lucy Reep shall have the right to repair and rebuild any thing that gets out of order on the plantation and pay the expense out of any of the above named property it is my will that after the death of my wife Mary Reep and my two daughters Elizabeth Reep & Lucy Reep that the above named property shall be equally divided among the children of my children their names as follows

George Reep, Philip Reep J. F. Reep
 died his heirs, and Daniel Reep
 provided he has heirs of his own body

It is my will that my son George Reep shall be executor to execute this my last will and Testament
