### Peter Summy's Will,

I Peter Summy of the County of Lincoln, and State of North Carolina do make the following is my last will and Testament, to wit:  
First. I direct that my debts and funeral expenses be paid.  
Second. I will and bequeath to my son Peter Summy, twenty five hundred dollars.  
Third. I will and bequeath to my wife Harriet Caroline my House and Lot in Lincolnton, in which I now live, my plantation about one mile from Lincolnton, on the Jacksonville and Beavertown joining lands of H. Canale & others, & my household and Kitchen furniture for and during her natural life, and a sufficient quantity of <sup>personal</sup> property or money for a years support for herself and family. I also will absolutely to my wife Harriet Caroline the following Slaves, to wit: Sophia, Mariah, Jack, Sonira, Victoria, Gule, Martha and Adeline. I wish also all the balance of my estate both real and personal with the remainder after my wifes death in my house and Lot and plantation & household and Kitchen furniture to be equally divided between my children George & Summy, Caroline Durenburg, Barbara Alexander, & Peter Summy, with the understanding that the negroes that

I have already given to my Son George shall be taken into account in said distribution.

Fifth I will that the third of my Estate willed to my daughter Barbara Alexander be for the sole and separate use of her and her children & I appoint my Son Peter A Summy trustee of my said daughter Barbara & her children.

Lastly. I appoint my Sons George & Peter the Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
