In the name of God Amen.
I Philip Anthony of the County of Lincoln &
State of North Carolina, being weak in body
and knowing that it is appointed for all men
once to die and as I am yet in sound mind
and memory, blessed be God for his mercy, I
think proper to make this my last Will & Testa-
ment. I do hereby make and publish this my
last Will & Testament, in the following manner
and form. First, I recommend my immortal soul
into the hands of Almighty God who gave it,
and my body to the Earth to be buried in a decent
and Christian manner, and the Expenses thereof
to be paid out of my Estate.
Secondly, That all my lawful debts be paid out
of my Estate.
Thirdly, I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife
Meria, two hundred and fifty dollars silver, two
Cows, four hogs, two Sheep, these she shall have
at her own disposal choice out of my stock

for a chest two beds & bed furniture, likewise all the
kitchen at her choice. This spring house and a stable
for her cows and sheep.

Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my son Paul the
Plantation, Snow hill and also another tract lying on
the waters of Pikes Creek, joining Pauls old tract
and Philip Sarrats tract. I command that my son
shall not take or receive, if any other line, or better
title right to be any of the land of the tract now
described. Also another tract containing two hundred
and acres. In short I give and bequeath unto my
son Paul all my lands, which I have and possess
with all & every thing or premises, and plantations
utensils, horses, cattle, in short all my land and
personal Estate that are not willed to my beloved
wife.

Fourthly I direct and command that my son Paul
shall furnish my beloved wife, with a sufficient
dwelling house, so that she may be satisfied, and
where she may choose it. He shall likewise furnish
her at all times, with a horse, saddle and bridle
when she demands it of him, also yearly with
ten bushels of good wheat twenty bushels of
corn, Eight pounds of clean hacked flax, one
hundred and fifty pounds of pork, Eighteen
pounds of sugar, nine pounds of coffee. He shall
likewise feed her creatures sufficiently, with his own
feed, he shall also provide for all and every thing that
she may ask of him, so that it may be a commodity
very good for her use that is to say, Salt, Spices, a gilt

to wait on her fire-wood &c of her grove &c that shall only be to her so long as she remains my widow. Otherwise she shall the two hundred and fifty dollars, her bed & bedding & furniture her chest & her cloathing & furniture which she and shep.

Sixthly. I give & bequeath to my son Paul all my negroes Slaves, one man named Ned & one negro woman Sileny, and all the increase of her Seventhly. I appoint and constitute my son Paul as my Executor of this my last will & Testament hereby revoking all former Wills made by me, in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 23^d day of May in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty six
