

My Wills 1797.

In the Name of God Amen
I Philip Throup of the County of
Lincoln and in the County of Lincoln being in
good health (signable to eye and perfect mind
and memory) Thanks be given unto God. Calling
unto mind the mortality of my Body and knowing
that it is appointed for all men Once to die, do
Make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament
That is to say, principally, I bequeath of all I
Give and bequeath my soul into the hands of
Almighty God, That gave it unto my Body &
bequeath to the Church to be buried in decent
Clothing burial, at the discretion of my Executors
nothing doubting but at the general resurrection
I shall recover them again by the mighty power
of God, And as touching such worldly Estate
where with it has pleased God to bless me in
this life, I give, devise, and dispose of the same
in the following manner & form.

First, I give and bequeath to my wife Batharine
her maintenance on this land, And all the Stocks, hares
and Cattle, sheep, and hogs to be kept on said premises
to be made a support for the family & till the youngest
Child, Come of age, or the Widow dies, or should
marry, then the above property and lands, shall
belong to Henry Throup, Lev. Throup, Joan Throup
Joseph Throup, Philip Throup, Peter Throup
Solomon Throup, Rosanna Throup, Nancy
Throup, And my wife a Child part if she
marry, or a Child part when the youngest

Child become of Age, their property to be
divided Among themselves. Written 1792.

I give and bequeath to my son Elihu One
Cow and calf, I give and bequeath to my
son John One sheep. One dollar.

I give and bequeath to my son Jacob One
Dollar. I give and bequeath to my son Moses
One sheep One Dollar.

I give and bequeath to my son David One
Dollar.

I give and bequeath to my son Elias One
Dollar.

I give and bequeath to my daughter
One Dollar.

I give and bequeath to my daughter
One Dollar.

And I do hereby certify, resolve, revoke, & annul,
all and every other former Testament, Will, or any former
and Executions, by me made, or to be made, or to be
before named, null and void, and I do hereby
confirming, this and no other to be my last Will and
Testament, in Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & Seal this 8th day of December in
the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and
thirty six, And do appoint my son Elihu
Levi One sheep my slave to be my Executor.
In witness my hand and seal this 8th day of December
1836.
