I Sally Butler of Lincoln County North
Carolina being somewhat weak in mind
and sound memory & a disposing mind, do
make and constitute this my last will and
testament, after allowing me a devout burial
and all my just debts & pay debts I do will and
bequeath unto my two daughters Elizabeth and
Sally Butler all the interest now held by
virtue of a Sheriff's deed to all mine debts
claim to that part of the tract & land where
I now live and also I do give and bequeath
all my stock of cattle, hogs, sheep & my dwelling
house with all my house hold & kitchen furniture
crop of all kind &c to & equally divided between
Elizabeth Butler, Sally Butler, & my son Thornton
with the exception of my one half of my
Wells; I do hereby recommend my two daughters
Elizabeth & Sally Butler my faithful & careful
given under my hand this tenth day
of September 1832
