for ever And I the said Pittleton Pettillo do give
grant the said Negro girl with all profits & increase
unto the said Reuben Perkins his Executors Admin-
istrators and assigns against all ~~lawful~~ persons who
shall ~~be~~ warrant & forever defend by these
presents In witness whereof I hereunto set my
