my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to
Die do make and ordain this my last will and testament
that is to say principally First of all I give and bequeath my
soul into the hand of Almighty God that gave it and my
body I recommend to be buried in a decent Christian
Burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting
but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again
by the Mighty power of God and as touching such worldly
estate whereunto it has pleased God to bless me in this life
I give demise & dispose of the same in the following manner I give
and bequeath to my son John Johnson ten Shillings
And I also give to my Joseph Johnson ten Shillings
And I give to my Daughter Mary Johnson ten Shillings
And I give to my son Richard Johnson ten Shillings
And I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Johnson ten Shillings
And I give to my son John Johnson ten Shillings
And I give to my Daughter Rebecca Johnson ten Shillings
And I give to my Daughter Sarah Johnson ten Shillings
And I also give my dear & beloved wife my dwelling house
and all my lands during her life time or widowhood
and if she marries she is only to have a child's part
and at her death I do allow all my lands to be equally
divided between my children and I give my
wife all my household furniture and all my farming
tools and all my working instruments and all
my house beasts and all my cattle & hogs and sheep
and all my perishable property that I possess
in this world besides and at her death

I do authorize My wife with that authority and power
to divide this My perishable property between My children
as she sees proper and I do hereby utterly disavow Revokes
And Rescind all and every other former testaments
Legacies and executus by in any use before Mamed will do
Bequeathed Ratifying and confirming this My will
to be My last will and testament in witness hereof I have
hereunto set My hand and seal this fifteenth day of
February in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and twenty six Signed sealed Published and pronounced
And declared by the said Richard Johnson as his last
will and testament in the presence of us who in his presence
And in the presence of each other have subscribed our
Names test
