I Richard Rogers of Lincoln County do make this my
last full and entire will that all my Debts be paid
I purpose direct my Executors to sell such part of my
personal estate as in their opinion can be best spared
to the most suitable to affect this Object
I will to my wife Mary the tract of land on which I now
live during her life & at her death to my son Thomas & his heirs
in fee I also will my wife Mary (Died) to have during her life
& at her death to be Equally divided amongst all my children
to be sold & the Money equally divided of an equal
division can be at other time take place I will to my Daughter
Elizabeth Elmer Mary and her child Albert
also a horse called for saddle & bridle her bed & furniture
I will to my Daughter Ann my & Peter Cassell the tract
of land on which he now lives the said Peter Cassell
paying for same hundred Dollars for which sum he has
given me his note bearing date the 25th Feb 1826
also for a Holly and Gr of oil and one which boy George to
remain with his father & Mother until he comes to the
age of Eight Years also the sum of two hundred &
fifty Dollars in money to make the boy George a man
to serve I will to my son Peter the tract of land lying
on the north side of the river in the County of Lincoln
at the ferry also the Cat and Sack I will to my son
Richard the same on the south side of the Cataraugus
river in Westchester County at the Ferry also the
I will to my son James Eight hundred Dollars to be raised
out of that part of the estate given my other sons to
make him equal with them not having either him
any land while I live my other sons are to pay in
equal portions also I will him Abraham & Joseph
I will to my son Thomas the land on which

I have after his mother's death also Little William (Peg)
& Young John are the profits of the Ferry Fisheries
on the batonba river I will to my sons John Richard
& James & Thomas together with one acre of land on
each side of the river at the Ferry for all time
and it is my will that they shall not dispose of said shares
& Fisheries and that my son permit my other sons to use
my ^{bottom} from time to time to pick and pack their own bottom
I will to my Daughter Polly share her share in all
at the death of my wife Mary. My will is that my wife
have one year provision for her support at the death of
my further will is that my daughter & their husbands
have the privilege of picking & packing bottom at
my Machine from time to time the balance of my estate
I direct to be sold by my Executors & after payment of
debts to be equally divided amongst my children
also if there should be any other negro children
born from the ^{woman} killed my wife the same to be
equally divided I appoint Bartlett Shipp John
Rogel & Peter Canveller my Executors witness my
hand & seal this 26th day of February 1826
