In the name of God amen. I Robert Fitzgerald, Sheriff
of Lincoln County and the State of North Carolina
being of sound mind & memory and in health and
knowing the contents of the same to be my last
last will & testament. That it is my will that
all my debts which I owe be paid as soon
as the money which is due to me or a sufficient
quantity of it is collected I give and bequeath
that the two houses which I now own together
with my books medicines and instruments
and goods be sold at public sale on a
credit of six months & after I give and bequeath
to my brother in law Nicholas L. Fitzgerald
my town lot & to which I own in Crook
North Carolina counties to him his heirs & assigns
forever 4thly I bequeath to my nephew
Allison Colwith Headwell fifty dollars to my
nephew William L. Headwell fifty dollars
to my niece Eliza Headwell fifty
dollars which sums of money must
be put out at interest and the interest

of which must be applied severally to the education of my said nephews and niece until they arrive at the age of twenty one years then it is my will that the principal be paid to them and I do hereby appoint their father James of Seabrook their trustee for conveying this part of my will into effect & I will bequeath to each of my half brothers & sisters ten dollars to be paid to them as soon as the debt owing to me shall be collected & I give to my daughter Fanny Ann fifty dollars to be paid to her when the debts owing to me are collected & I give to my brother in law James of Seabrook my blue cloth cloak and all the rest of my clothes I give to my Mother Fanny Ann to be disposed of at her pleasure & I give to my sister Eliza Seabrook my gold watch & watch chain together with all the balance of my estate not herein before disposed of and I appoint James P Henderson of Lincoln County to execute this my last will & testament in testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this 21st day of March in the year of our Lord 1831 signed & acknowledged in the presence of
