may arrive of age or such time as they may think proper.

11th And I do hereby constitute & appoint my beloved sons
David Shaford & Daniel Shaford to be my executors of this
my last will & testament. In witness whereof I have

at her death & furthermore. I bequeath unto Margaret my de-
loved wife that she shall have from my son Robert a good
decent & reasonable living during her life time. It is also
my will that she shall be entitled, authorized to occupy
my Mansion house & other out houses as to her may appear
necessary for her accommodation or any part thereof
during her life. Item. I give & bequeath to my son Robert
G Ramsay the plantation I now live on & furthermore. Give
& bequeath unto my son Robert G Ramsay the half of my
hundred & twenty acre tract of land to be taken of the
North side containing all the meadow ground on the
big branch. Item, I give & bequeath unto my two grand
children, Robert Ramsay & Annery & Michael William Sumner
when they come to the age of twenty one my fifty acre tract
lying on both sides of the big branch & the half of my
hundred & twenty acre tract to be taken of the South side
& each piece to be equally divided between them. Item, I
give & bequeath to my son Robert G Ramsay the land above
mentioned for my two grand children until they come to the
age of twenty one. Item, I give & bequeath to my son in law
George Sumner five shillings Sterling. Item, I likewise consti-
tuted Ordain my well beloved son Robert G Ramsay my only
sole & Executor of this my last will & testament & do hereby set
- aby this day, heretofore & upon all & every other for more to

this named, willed bequeathed, Ratifying & Confirming this
