In the Name of God Amen I Samuel Blackard
of the State of North Carolina & County of
Lincoln being in an weak state of health
but of sound mind and memory do make
constitute and appoint this my last will
and testament and first I recommend my
soul to God who gave it and my body to
be buried in a decent Christian manner
and as for such worldly estate as it hath
pleased God to bestow unto me I will and bequeath
in the following manner I bequeath my funeral expenses
and all lawful debts to be paid & I bequeath
to my beloved wife Nancy the plantation
that I now live on which consists of three
different tracts joining to other to live and
upset as long as she lives also all my my
stock of horses & my stock of cattle also
my stock of ~~peep~~ and my stock of hogs
and loom and harnessing & my farming tool
three beds & furniture also all my household
and kitchen furniture to dispense of as she
pleases I also bequeath to my wife Nancy
my Waggon & gear & one ^{people} ~~one~~ man
called Joel & dinner all to the use and
support of my wife Nancy &
children that now live with me John
and Avery Nancy and family I also
bequeath to my daughter Jane one bed
& furniture one saddle and bridle one
Walnut chest one spinning wheel
bequeath to my daughter Nancy one bed
& furniture one saddle and bridle one
Walnut chest one spinning wheel

also bequeath to my daughter Eleanor one
bed and furniture saddle & bridle one
walnut chest one spinning wheel & also bequeath
wealth to my son Barnard all the lands that
I now own at the death of his mother also
one sould mare and with what he now
claims one saddle & bridle the wife of me
I also bequeath to my grandson Daniel
Dithrey one shirt of white of my child
born that are preserved and left me I
have given them these three share of my estate
I likewise do appoint Gideon Blackwood
my son Daniel executors of this my
last will & testament and to disannul
all former wills by me made I declare
this & this only to be my last will & testament
by witness whereof I have set my hand
and fixed my seal this 17th day of January
in the year of our Lord 1632 by me
sealed & published in presence of me
