In the name of God. I, Samuel
I Samuel Collins, Son of Samuel Collins County and
State of North Carolina being of sound and
disposing mind & memory do make & ordain
this my last Will & Testament in Manner & form
as follows: That my body be buried decently
& all my last debts be paid & my funeral charges
be paid by my executors hereafter named
1st I will unto my beloved Wife Martha her
Feather Bed & bed Clothing, also her Saddle &
bridle, also her Cow & calf and herifer also
my red Cow & yearling & three kind of Sheep
also one Sow & pigs also one year maintenance
of Corn & meat also feed for her Stock to be
her own forever. 2nd I will & bequeath
to my son Jonathan telling, certain part
of my land lying at lower end of the plan-
tation. Beginning at the Mouth of the Spring
branch where it empties into the new ditch

Running with the Branch up to the other
house to the line then with said line &
fence near a West Course to a pine corner
a corner of Samuel Collins, Jonathan Collins
and John Jackson lot. Thence with said Samuel
Collins & Jonathan Collins line near a North Course
crossing creek & swamp to a post oak on said line
thence a straight course towards the beginning and
it comes to the old ditch thence with said old
ditch to the new ditch thence with the said
new ditch to the beginning to be to his use for

4th I will & bequeath unto my daughter Susan
Collins her bed & furniture which was always
allowed for her to be to her use forever

5th I will the balance of my property to be sold
including my stock of horses, mares & colts, sheep
hogs, house hold and kitchen furniture, also my
saddle & farming tools, also all my land that I
own now in possession of except what I have
already willed to my son Jonathan Collins

and 6th I will that my sons Samuel Collins, son
Joseph Collins & Thomas Collins & Susanah
Collins shall have Seventy Dollars, each and
thence the rest of my estate to be equally among
all my heirs Thence all the rest of my heirs

and 7th I do nominate & appoint my son
Jonathan Collins and George Goforth my
Executors to this my last will & testament & all
nothing all others, bequeath & acknowledge
in presence of us this 28th day of December in
the year of our Lord 1835
