In the name of God Amen
I Jacob Reinhardt son of the County of
Lincoln and State of North Carolina being
of sound & perfect mind & memory do hereby
be God do this twenty sixth day of July in
the year of Our Lord one thousand eight
hundred & thirty two, make & publish this my
last will & Testament in manner following
that is to say I recommend my soul to God
who gives it & my body to the earth to be buried
in a christian like manner and as to the
worldly property or Estate which with it has pleased
God to bless me with, I do allow give & bequeath
in the following manner to wit

First, I allow all my just debts to be paid
and funeral charges that is claimed.

2nd I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Eliza
Reinhardt one cow and calf one bear & bearstead
& furniture one set of spurs two plates one set of
knives & forks a spoon one table & six sack, coffee mill
a flax wheel & a pair of cards a sugar box one
pot & dutch oven two saddles, & flint fork one
bark pear one chest one pot back also two
one Sheep one breeding sow the above property
with the further increase of the cow & sheep
though my will is that my wife shall have
during ^{her} natural lifetime & at her death it
shall be equally divided between my seven
daughters that is to say Molly wife of Christopher
Kinsinger Catherine wife of John Rudick, Eliza
Reinhardt, Rachell Reinhardt, Susannah
Reinhardt, Christiana Reinhardt, Mary
Reinhardt but if my wife should marry my will

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is that at the time she alters her name
by marriage the above said property shall
properly belong to the above said John & another
& shall be divided at that time.

3rd I give & bequeath to my son Isaac
Reinhardt one horse best falling ax & mallets,
my will is that he have the same, properly clear from
the rest of my children.

4th My will is that all the balance of my
property, living stock of every kind, farming tools
household furniture & dishes, furniture of every kind
of a sixth & fourth cent value at my death shall
be sold, that I have not willed or bequeathed

in this my last will, and the money arising from
the same shall be equally divided between my
wife Clara my seven daughters that is to say
Holly, Catherine, Sally, Rachel, Susannah,
Christian, & Mary Reinhardt.

5th My daughter Margaret Reinhardt
wife of George Macaster that is dead
leaving one heir John Macaster, my will
is that he shall draw away eight of his mother's
out of my estate one dollar and no
more.

And I revoke an a disannull all and
every other will & declare this to be my
last will and Testament.

And I hereby make and ordain my
worthy friend Major Hubert Executor of
this my last will and Testament in
witness whereof I the said Jacob Reinhardt
have to this my last will Testament
