In the name of God Amen. I Sarah Robinson
of the County of Lincoln & State of North Carolina, being
sick in body, but perfect in mind & Memory, knowing that
it is appointed for all once to die, do make the following
my last Will & Testament in the manner & form as follows
1st It is my will & devise that my two Negroes namely
Peter & Hannah remain on the old place where they are now
living. the above named Peter is to be sold by my son provided
he wants to be sold, My son Melchisedech is to take charge
of the above named Hannah 2^d I give & bequeath
unto my son Melchisedech One bed & furniture 3^d I give
& bequeath unto my daughters each One bed & furniture
4th It is my will & desire that my son Melchisedech
take his part out of my property & the balance of my
property to be equally divided among my sons & daughters
5th It is my will that my stock shall be sold at public
sale, I nominate & appoint my son Melchisedech
& H. K. Robinson my Executors I pronounce this
to be my last will & Testament In witness whereof
I set my hand & seal this 3^d day of June 1834.
